

# INDEX CARD FOR JOHANN JAKOB GUTH Zweibrückener Beamtenkartei collection

Alex Bueno-Edwards of NY, NY (Manhattan), abueno@alumni.princeton.edu, has provided a copy of the index card for Johann Jakob Guth from the Zweibrückener Beamtenkartei collection. The Zweibrückener Stadtsarchiv (city archive) has an extensive collection of these cards for people who were officials. You'll notice it refers on front and back to several autobiographies – the official at the archive told Alex that they have no idea where these autobiographies are, or if they still exist after the devastation of WW2. In any case the most important point from the card for this family, is that Johann Jakob Guth's autobiography said he was born in Oberbrunn. There are 4 towns called Oberbrunn in Germany, and Alex listed them in his handwriting at the top of the front side of the card. Of course there may be towns called Oberbrunn in Switzerland or Austria. More likely though, the Oberbrunn in question is in fact modern "Oberbronn" in Alsace, about 17km NW of Hagenau.

# JOHN GOOD AND THE 3RD REGIMENT EAST TENNESSEE MILITIA

The following are the Military records from the War of 1812 for "a" John Good from East Tennessee that Vicki got from the National Archives. She requested the following: John Good, 3 reg't (Johnson's) E. Tennessee militia, roll box 83, roll exct 602; John Good, 1 Reg't (Hall's) Tennessee Volunteers, Roll Box 83, roll exct 602; Form 85A Full Pension File and Form 86 Military Service Records - Complete file.

# THIS IS THE WAY IT WAS, BY LARA GOOD

"According to Lara Good in his book, *This is the Way It Was*, John Wesley Good never knew his grandfather, John Good, since his grandfather died 8 years before he was born. However, he remembered his grandmother, Susannah Good, wife of John Good. John W. Good said that Susannah remarked that John Good had served in the Army, as had his father before him. He also said that he (John Good) had been to South America for a time. He said John's father, Samuel, had owned a plantation in Virginia, and he (John Good) had served in the Army in the Indiana frontier some years before he migrated west. He said he was

a dour individual, and had cut loose from his family in Virginia because of something disagreeable."

[ed hg: Currently I am not listing a father for John Good (1788-1847) even though Lara Good reports that John Wesley Good said that his father was Samuel Good, who owned a plantation in Virginia, as the report lacks a citation. However, it is an item to be researched.]

"As to the military records, there is no way to tell for sure if this is the same John Good, since this is the extent of the records. However, I did a little research into this regiment finding the following:"

[ed hg: In Greene County, Tennessee there is only one John Good listed in the 1830 Federal Census. Based on the age ranges and number of children, this census fits the John Good - Susannah Smeltzer family with one exception, it is missing either Samuel or Henry, both having been born in the 15-20 age category. Samuel's future father-in-law is living just a short distance away (Valentine Catron).]

#### **BRIEF HISTORY:**

Part of General Nathaniel Taylor's brigade, this unit of drafted militia (about 900 men) was mustered in at Knoxville and marched to the vicinity of Mobile via Camp Ross (present-day Chattanooga), Fort Jackson, Fort Claiborne, and Fort Montgomery. Along the way the men were used as road builders and wagon guards. Many of them were stationed at Camp Mandeville (near Mobile) in February 1814, where there was much disease. For example, the company of Captain Joseph Scott had thirty-one listed sick out of an aggregate of 104 at the final muster.

Vicki adds, "It is also possible John Good was in the Indian Wars in Indiana, but I have not found a record."
